

Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools

Are you interested in working in a support role in school? Do you already volunteer or work in school? Do you want to learn more and progress in your role? Then we have courses for you.



Passport to Supporting in Schools is a free, six-hour short course, suitable for anyone interested in working as a teaching assistant or midday supervisor or if you have some past experience and want to get ready to apply for a new role.

Becoming a Teaching Assistant* is a free, 5 week course, suitable for anyone interested in becoming a teaching assistant or already volunteering in a school. It will help you to decide if working in a school is right for you before committing to progressing onto a qualification.

Level 2 Award in Support Work in Schools is a knowledge based qualification suitable for anyone wanting to work in a supporting role in school, whether you have already started working or volunteering in schools or if you have not yet started.
