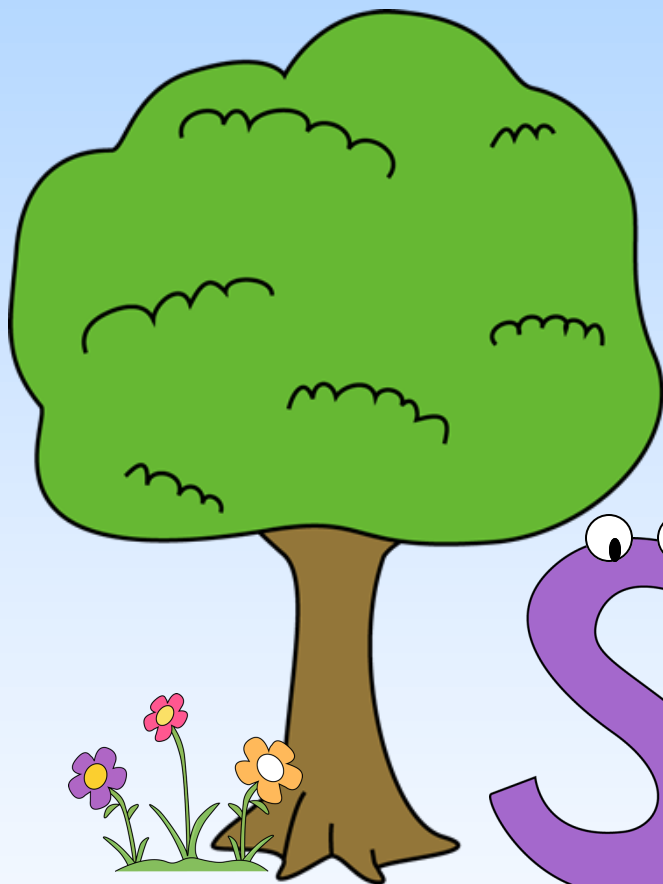
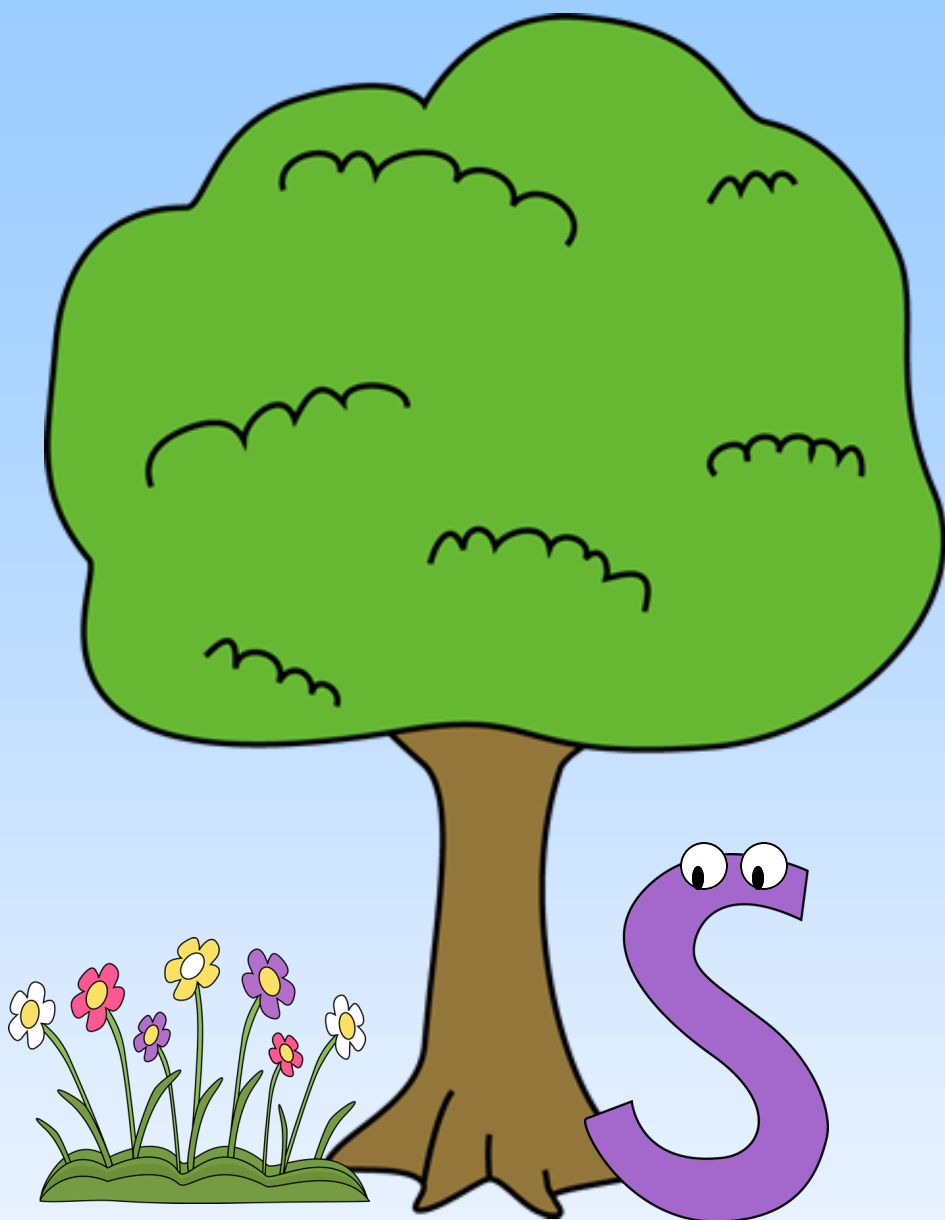


The Story of 'SH'

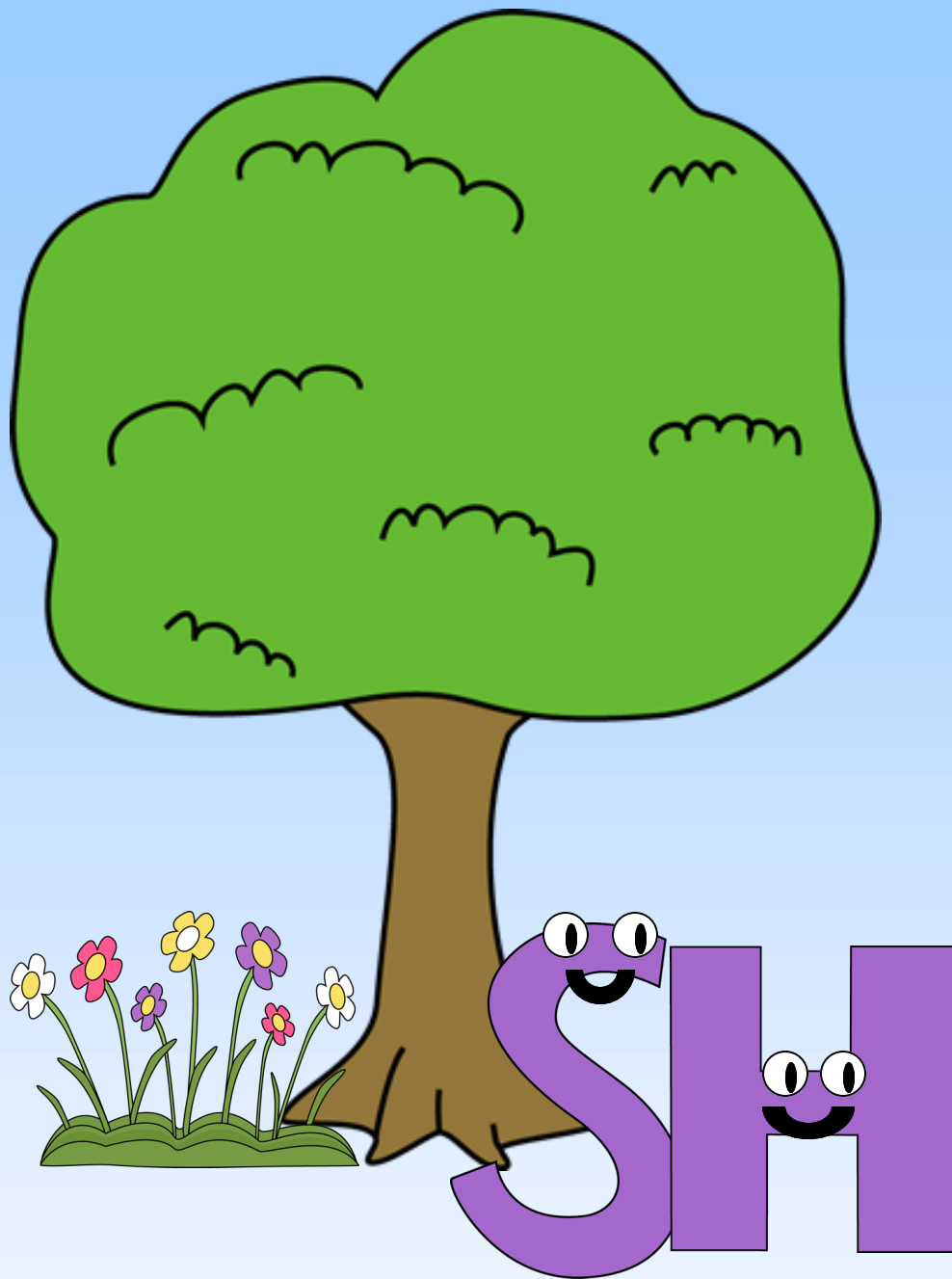
Once there was a lovely S

But instead, got stuck to S's side.

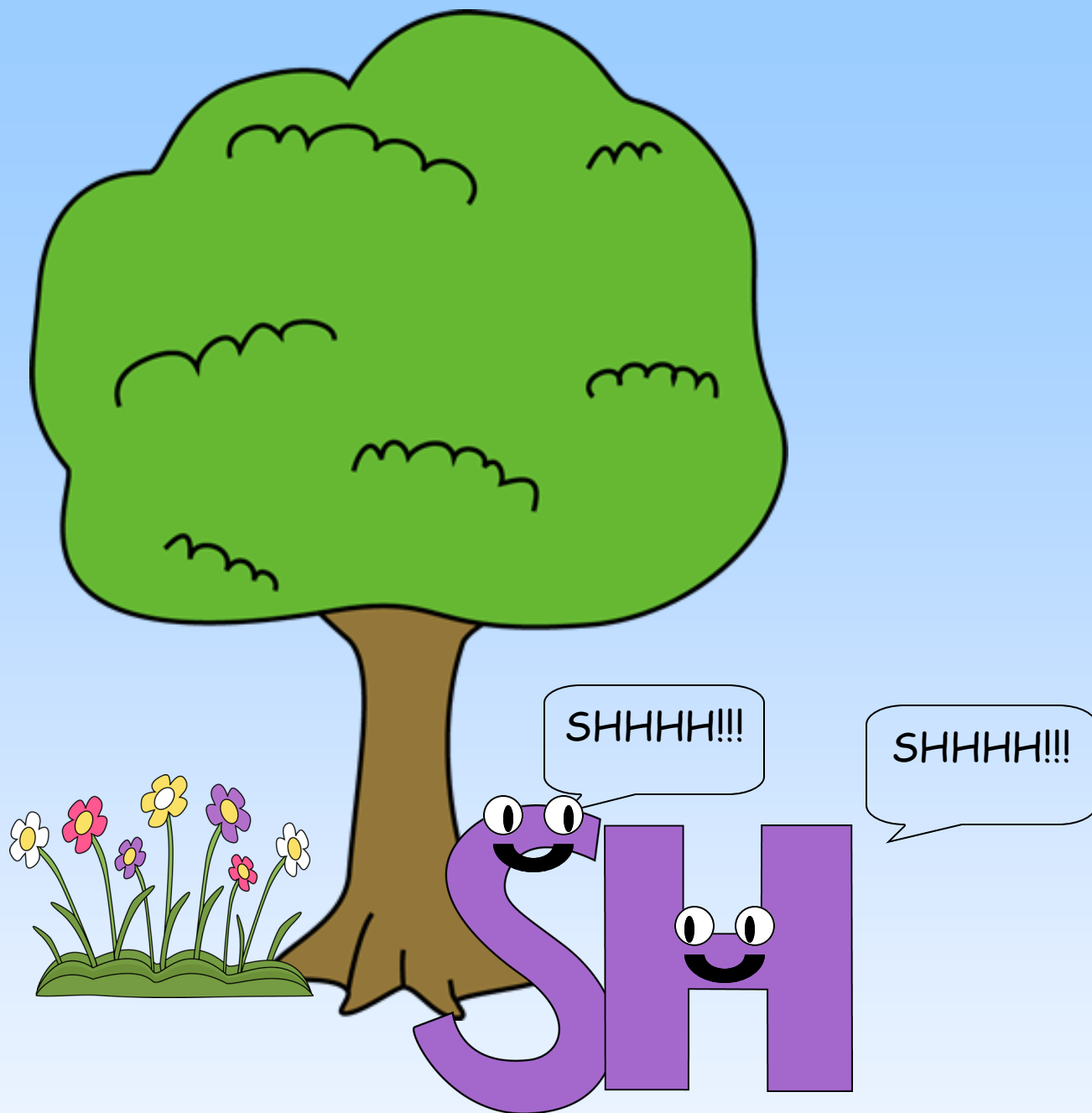


"Aw!" said S, "Get off of me!"
