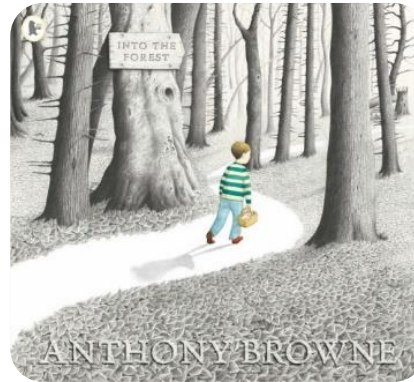


English
