PE is every Monday. Children must come into school in their PE kits.

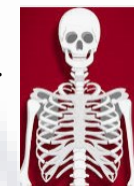
The sport we will be practising will be:

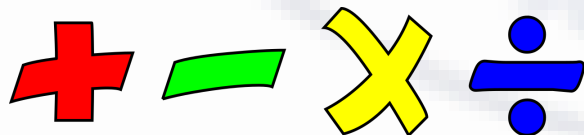

We will be looking at developing children's understanding of multiplication and division, money and statistics.

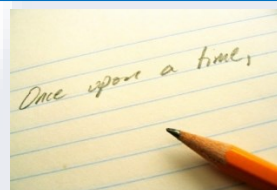
How you can help at home
