PE

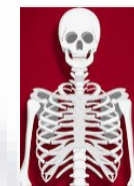
PE is every Monday. Children must come into school in their PE kits.

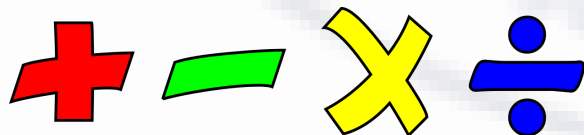

We will be looking at developing children's understanding of statistics and length and perimeter.

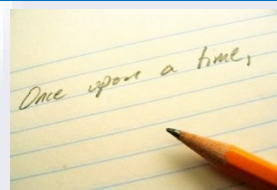
How you can help at home
