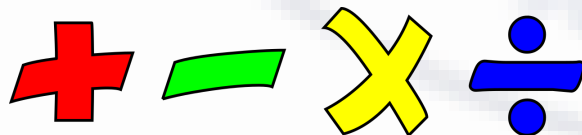

Maths

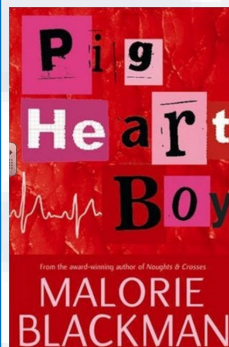
This half term we will be focussing on developing our skills in the following areas of maths:
