Relationships and Sex Education (RSE)

Dear Parents,

Our RSE lessons will be taught over the course of a week after half term (your child's class teacher will be able to tell you the exact dates their class will be teaching them).

As part of the DfE guidance, parents are unable to withdraw their child from relationships education. Local Authority primary schools are required by law to teach National Curriculum Science, which includes some elements of sex education. Again, parents do not have a right to withdraw their child from this. Parents are able to withdraw their child from non-statutory elements and this can be done by arranging an appointment with the school to discuss this. At Stopsley, we do not teach any non-statutory elements except in Year 6.
