Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to holding our school sports day this year. We will be hosting our sports days as follows:-

YR, Y1 and Y2 – Thursday 15th June 9.30-11.00am

Y3 and Y4 – Wednesday 14th June 9.30 – 11.00am

Y5 and Y6 – Friday 16th June 9.30 – 11.00am

We organise our sports day over the three age phases to offer the opportunity for children to participate in more activities with more space and to be able to have more spectators at each event. As a result of holding our sports day over three different dates, it gives us increased space so we can allow more families to attend to cheer on their children safely.

The children will participate in house teams and will be awarded points for each event. At the end of their sports day, all of the points from across the three sports days are calculated and these are then added to the house points earned throughout the year in class to create an overall winner. The overall winner will be announced in assembly during July.

As a change for this year, we will be trialing some 'mini-parent challenges' in between events. Parents are able to earn house points for their child's house by participating if they wish to! Examples of the type of events are: ball 'keepy-uppy' challenge, skipping challenge and tennis ball balance. Please do give the challenges a go if you can – the children will love it!

On the date above, your child will need to wear their sports kit all day. The children can wear the coloured t-shirt that matches their house colour if they wish to. Please make sure that you provide your child with a water bottle. Please also make sure they have sun cream applied before they come to school as they will be competing outside all morning. Our house colours are below:-

Red – Romans

Yellow – Saxons

Blue – Vikings

Green - Normans

If you are coming to watch your child on sports day, entry and exit is via the Coop car park gate only. Please walk up the runway to the field to join us. Unfortunately, there will be limited toilet facilities to use within the school grounds. We look forward to seeing you at this year's sports day.
