## Maths

This half term the children will be developing their understanding of place value in numbers up to a million and will explore negative numbers. They will also be practising their addition and subtraction skills.

## Homework

In Year 5, the children are expected to read daily, practise their timetables and practise spellings in preparation for a
weekly test.

## English

The children in Year 5 will start the year by revising and recapping key writing, grammar and punctuation skills. They will then focus on story writing and composition: learning the skills and techniques used by effective writers and applying them in their own work.
