RE

We will be exploring what it means for Christians to believe that God is holy and loving. The children will start to make connections between biblical texts and Christian beliefs and will begin to understand how Christians put their beliefs into practice.

PE

PE is every Monday afternoon.

Children will need to come to school in their PE kit.

This half term the children will focus on football and gymnastics,



Science

In science, the children will be looking at properties of materials and finding out about reversible and irreversible change. The children will develop their scientific thinking and will carry out a number of experiments.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term the children will be developing their understanding of place value in numbers up to a million and will explore negative numbers. They will also be practising their addition and subtraction skills.

<u>Homework</u>

In Year 5, the children are expected to read daily, practise their timetables and practise spellings in preparation for a weekly test.

English

The children in Year 5 will start the year by revising and recapping key writing, grammar and punctuation skills. They will then focus on story writing and composition: learning the skills and techniques used by effective writers and applying them in their own work.

History

We will be doing a local area study in history and finding out about how Luton had changed over the years. We will also begin to find out about World War Two.

PSHE

This half term we will be focussing on the children's wellbeing and resilience through weekly PSHE lessons.



French

This half term the children will be finding out how to talk about themselves in French.
