**SPORTS DAY 2026**

Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to our school sports day on **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June**. We will be hosting sports day as one full day this year with our Nursery having their own sports day on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July (separate information about this will follow). For all children in Reception to Year 6, our sports day timings are as follows:

Year groups	Times
Y1 and Y2 (KS1)	09:00am – 10:30am
Y3 and Y4 (LKS2)	10:45am – 12:15pm
Reception	12:45pm – 1:45pm
Y5 and Y6 (UKS2)	2:00pm – 3:25pm

We hope that lots of parents will join us for sports day. We appreciate that some parents will need to join us at different times to watch siblings but we have to take into account the total number of children and spectators that are on our field and we must manage this event both efficiently and safely. If you are coming to watch your child, entry and exit is via the Co-op car park gate only (at the end of the runway). Please walk up the path to the field to join us. Please be aware that there will be limited toilet facilities for adults to use when on the school grounds.

Sports day will have a carousel of activities which all children participate in. They will perform in House teams and will be awarded points for each event based on how they do, as well as their sporting attitude and teamwork. After this, some children will take part in competitive running, jumping and throwing events which also earn points. These selected children are chosen by our PE staff based on their ability within class PE lessons. By having these two parts to our sports day, it enables us to offer 'sport for all' as well as an aspect of 'competitive sport' (which several children often ask us for). At the end of the session, all of the points across the four sessions are calculated and are then added to our House Points earned throughout the year (in class), creating our overall winning House. The overall winner will be announced in our assembly at the end of the term. The winners of each sports day session will be shared with parents as part of a short presentation which will take place at the end of each sports day session.

On the date above, your child will need to wear their sports kit all day. The children can wear a coloured t-shirt that matches their House colour if they wish to. Please ensure that you provide your child with a named water bottle on the day and they should have sun cream applied before they come to school – they will be competing outside for a lengthy period. Our House colours are below:

House	Colour
Normans	Green
Romans	Red
Saxons	Yellow
Vikings	Blue

We ask parents to be respectful when parking on the residential streets near the school and not to block any driveways. Please also extend the same courtesy to the Co-op car park. Although this is free, it is restricted with the number of cars that can park there. Thank you for your continued support and we look forward to seeing you on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
