Year 6 – PGL Liddington, Residential Visit (September 2026)

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have provisionally booked an activity residential visit for all children going into Year 6 next year. The visit takes place from **Monday 28th September** until **Wednesday 30th September 2026**. The visit will be to the PGL Liddington Multi Activity Centre, which is in Swindon, Wiltshire.

The cost of the visit will be **£253.33** which includes all activities, food, accommodation, transport and insurance.

During the three day and two night stay, the children will take part in a variety of activities, such as: climbing, team building skills, high ropes, abseiling, archery, etc. Further details of the site and activities, as well as pictures, can be found at: www.pgl.co.uk

We made the change last year for the year 6 residential trip to be earlier than in previous years, to help the children and adults get to know each other much better and of course they benefit from this in the year ahead. This was successful and as a school we feel it gets year 6 (your child's final year at Stopsley) off to a great start too.

A letter will be sent home after the Christmas break outlining full details of the payment plan, including a deposit for this residential. This means that parents will be able to pay for the cost of the residential from January right up until the end of the summer term (July).

The trip will be an enjoyable experience where the children will have the opportunity to take part in many fun activities. The experience really builds their independence and confidence for the year ahead and for their transition to High School. We hope that all children will attend.
