Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Tuesday 16th June**, we will be having a Non-Uniform Day with the theme of celebrating culture, heritage and identity. This will be a special opportunity for our school community to come together and recognise the things that make us proud of who we are.

Children are encouraged to wear clothing that reflects something meaningful about their cultural background, family traditions, personal heritage, or simply what makes them proud to be themselves.

This could include traditional or cultural dress, colours or symbols of a country or region, or even clothing related to a hobby, sport or because that represents their heritage and/or identity.

This is a day to promote inclusion, respect and pride that includes everyone. Students are warmly encouraged to celebrate their identity in any way that is meaningful to them. For some, this might mean wearing a football shirt, or items reflecting their participation in clubs, such as a Brownies or Cubs uniform.
