We will be exploring what it means for Christians to believe that God is holy and loving. The children will start to make connections between biblical texts and Christian beliefs and will begin to understand how Christians put their beliefs into practice.

Science

In science, the children will be looking at properties of materials and finding out about reversible and irreversible change. The children will develop their scientific thinking and will carry out a number of experiments.

Maths

This half term the children will be developing their understanding of place value in numbers up to a million and will explore negative numbers. They will also be practising their addition and subtraction skills.

Homework

In Year 5, the children are expected to read daily, practise their times tables and practise spellings in preparation for a weekly spelling test.

English

The children in Year 5 will start the year by revising and recapping key writing, grammar and punctuation skills. They will then focus on story writing and composition: learning the skills and techniques used by effective writers and applying them in their own work.

Geography

This half term the children will be learning about the geography of the UK. They will find out about key geographical features, the counties of the UK and finding out about mountains, rivers and coastal regions.

PSHE

This half term we will be focussing on the children's wellbeing and resilience through weekly PSHE lessons.



French

This half term the children will be finding out how to talk about themselves in French. They will learn to say some words and phrases in simple future tense.
