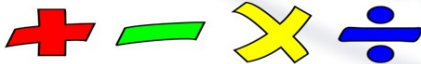
Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter

Maths

Maths this term focuses on securing the children's understanding of place value in numbers up to 10,000,000, ordering and comparing large numbers, rounding to the nearest power of 10, the four operations and the order of operations. They will continue to develop their fluency and will practise arithmetic and times tables daily.

How you can help at home

Encourage your child to play IT Rock Stars to help with their times tables.



English

The children in Year 6 will start the year by revising and recapping key writing, grammar and punctuation skills. They will then focus on writing our very own myth and legend story alongside writing a newspaper report. Their reading and writing in term one will be based around the topic of the Vikings and we will be reading both 'The Viking Boy' and 'Beowulf'.



How you can help at home

Encourage your child to read at home every night for 20 minutes and then questions about what they have read. Encourage your child to keep a diary to write about their experiences.
