## PE

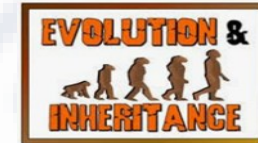
PE is every Thursday afternoon. Children must come in to school wearing their PE kit on this day.

## Maths

## English

The children will continue to write in a range of genres, including writing a formal diary entry from the perspective of a woman Suffragette, which links to our History topic. Alongside this, we will write stories linked to this particular period of time and reports on how the Suffragette movement was so important.



## PSHE

Over the course of the autumn term, we will be taking part in lots of different lessons focussing on well-being and mental health. We will be thinking about how we look after ourselves and others.



## French

We will be exploring language to use when shopping in a French supermarket.

We will learn to pronounce these accurately and write these down in French words.

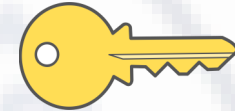


## History
