

## RE

In RE we will be learning about miracles.

Children will have the opportunity to explore stories from different religions and consider how miracles are displayed through religion. They will also compare the idea of miracles to scientific views.

## PE

In PE this half term, the children will be refining their striking skills using different equipment, developing control and accuracy in putting and basic batting techniques. They will practise these skills in cricket and golf.



## Science

In Science, children will be learning about animals and humans. They will begin the topic by labelling and identifying different parts of human and animal skeletons. They will then find out about the types of food and nutrients humans need in order to keep healthy.



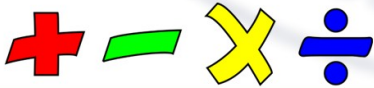

# Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter

## Maths

We will be looking at developing children's understanding of fractions. Children will build on their learning from Year 2 by identifying unit and non-unit fractions, understanding a whole and ordering and comparing fractions.

We will also be learning about mass and capacity. We will measure mass in grams and kilograms and capacity in litres and millilitres.



## English

This half term, children will be exploring poetry. We will be writing Kenning and shape poems and exploring poetic features such as alliteration, similes and onomatopoeia.

We will also be writing a story ending based on the story Greta and the Giants. We will be using speech and fronted adverbials as our main skills.



## Geography

In Geography, we will be comparing rural and urban areas across England. We will be exploring land use and the different ways that land has been developed over time. Using this information, we will consider why people choose to live in certain places.

We will also be using atlases to locate countries around the world and explore different climate zones.
