PE is still on Thursday afternoon. This half term we will be looking at improving our tennis skills by focusing on serving, forehand and backhand.

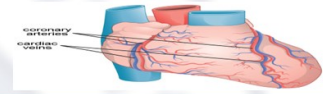
Children **must** come in wearing their PE kit on this day.

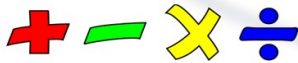
# Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter
