Camping Trip Rescheduled

Dear Parents and carers,

After careful consideration, we have made the decision to reschedule the camping trip from this Friday to **Tuesday 14th July** due to the extreme weather warning that has been issued for this week.

This decision was not taken lightly. We carefully reviewed the situation and placed the health, safety, and wellbeing of our pupils at the centre of our discussions. Given the forecast conditions, we believe that postponing the trip is the most responsible course of action and will allow us to provide a safer and more enjoyable experience for everyone involved.

We also spoke with the pupils who are due to attend the camping trip. They were very understanding and agreed that they would prefer to wait and take part in the full camping experience at a later date, rather than proceed this Friday with a significantly reduced or simplified version of the trip because of the weather restrictions.

By rescheduling the camping trip to **Tuesday 14th July**, we are confident that pupils will have the opportunity to enjoy all of the planned activities and gain the full benefits of the experience in a safe and positive environment.

Important Information

- On Tuesday 14th July, children should attend school as normal.
- The camping experience will begin on the school grounds at 3:30pm.
- Children will need to bring a packed tea/evening meal for the camp.
- Please ensure that children bring suitable clothing, overnight items and toiletries for the camping experience.
- On Wednesday, pupils attending the camp will complete their camping activities before the experience concludes. Following this, we will be planning a range of fun, team-building and group activities for the whole year group to take part in together.
- We encourage children to have a school dinner on Wednesday. However, if they would prefer a packed lunch, this can be brought into school on Tuesday and we will store it safely in a school fridge overnight.
- Children are encouraged to wear sports clothing on Wednesday and should bring appropriate clothes for the day's activities.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support and we apologise for any inconvenience caused. We look forward to a successful camping trip on **Tuesday 14th July**.
